Every competitor will do their test twice and get a score for each time. Each competitor will come in at their prescribed time—do the test—then the judge will talk to them and give them ideas about how to improve. The competitor will then do the test a second time, without ever leaving the arena. Their best score will go towards the final placing.

To arrive on the grounds please bring a check payable to Emerald-Glen, a negative coggins and proof of rabies. We also request that you pick up any "leavings" from your horse. There will be wheelbarrows and forks throughout the show grounds for such purposes.

Notes and Rules:

No Smoking or Alcohol on the show grounds

Helmets and a signed entry form are required for ANYONE mounted on the show grounds.

Class 1 and 2 are for walk-trotters and very young horses

Class 3 and 4 tend to have the most riders in them, for horses and riders that can canter circles.

Test of Choice: Let us know ahead of time and bring your own copy. We do have a PA system if you would like to do a freestyle.

Prix Caprilli Test #1 - For horses with jumping experience showing Training Level Dressage or above - maximum height of fences 2 feet.

Prix Caprilli Test #2 - for Horses with jumping experience competing First Level and above - maximum height of fences 2'6".

Western Dressage: For Western riders that can canter circles. Similar to a reining pattern, to be judged on paces, submission, impulsion, and rider's position. May be combined with Training Test 1. Riders may use two hands or one, but can not switch back and forth.

Attire is Informal—Breeches and boots or jodhpurs and paddock boots—polo shirt. Braiding is optional. Jeans and a collared shirt for Western Dressage.

Entry Fees

\$45 per class. \$35 per class for USPC or 4H members

Entries close when all spaces are filled. Your time will be posted on Emerald-Glen.com two days prior to the competition date.
